Guidelines for Proposers and Seconders for Applications for ACAA Membership.

- 1. These Guidelines set down the Obligations which members have when they act as the Proposer or the Seconder for an applicant for membership of the Association.
- 2. Applicants applying for Accredited Membership of the Association shall have the Application Form signed by a Proposer and a Seconder.
- 3. To propose or second an applicant for accredited membership of the Association requires that the Proposer and the Seconder shall be a financial, accredited member of the Association.
- 4. To propose or second an applicant for accredited membership of the Association requires the Proposer and Seconder to know the applicant in a professional capacity. This includes knowledge of their expertise and experience in the field of access for people with disabilities.
- 5. The specific knowledge that a Proposer or Seconder has of the applicant must relate to the recognised ACAA practice categories.
- 6. Members who act as a Proposer or Seconder must be willing to act as a referee and to discuss a membership application with the ACAA Membership Committee in order to validate information and knowledge they have regarding the applicant's professional expertise in the field of access for people with disabilities.
- 7. Applicants for Associate or Affiliate Membership working in rural and remote areas may appeal to the Management Committee to have a Proposer and a Seconder appointed. Rural and remote areas are defined for the purposes of these Guidelines as being located more than 200 km from the GPO of a capital city.
- 8. Applicants applying for Associate Membership of the Association may apply to the Management Committee to have a Proposer and a Seconder appointed.
- 9. Students applying for membership of the Association may apply to the Management Committee to have a Proposer and a Seconder appointed. Students would be granted Associate Membership.
- 10. Access Consultants practising entirely overseas applying for membership of the Association may apply to the Management Committee to have a Proposer and a Seconder appointed. Overseas practitioners would be granted Associate Membership.
- 11. Applicants applying for Affiliate Membership of the Association may apply to the Management Committee to have a Proposer and a Seconder appointed.
- 12. Organisations applying for membership of the Association as an Affiliate Organisation may apply to the Management Committee to have a Proposer and a Seconder appointed.
- 13. Proposers and Seconders appointed by the Management Committee are not required to have a prior knowledge of the applicant.
